"Go green" at the KidsKorner Spring Social

Featuring children's author Jennifer Keats Curtis on Friday, April 9

The Columbia Association (CA) is hosting its KidsKorner Spring Social, featuring children's author Jennifer Keats Curtis on Friday, April 9, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at Howard County Central Library. During the event, Ms. Curtis will present scientific information about bay animals, talk about the ways in which imagination and science are interwoven to create realistic fiction and read one of her illustrated children's books. The social is aimed at children ages 5-10. Registration is free for this event, and food will be provided. In addition, there will be prizes that will be raffled throughout the social. The event focuses on CA's efforts to encourage environmental awareness – as well as promote reading and writing skills and creativity in children.

KidsKorner Socials are free quarterly events for children that are both entertaining and educational. It gives local kids the opportunity to learn something new, make new friends and learn about CA and the KidsKorner initiative.

KidsKorner began in August 2007 as a supplemental web site to CA's online newsletter at www.CAmonthly.org. The site features contests, recipes, crafts, children's book reviews, local events for kids, games and educational resources. KidsKorner is also a TV segment on CA's television show, "Columbia Matters." The program airs on TV cable channels 96 and 98 on Comcast and channels 41 and 44 on Verizon, as well as online at www.ColumbiaMatters.org. Kids in the community have the opportunity to host this segment by e-mailing CATVshow@ColumbiaAssociation.com. Finally, KidsKorner sends an e-Newsletter at the start of every month with updates about exciting opportunities and activities for children. The e-Newsletter is a fantastic resource to stay informed and get kids more involved in their community.
