General Camp Information

Each camper will receive two 30-minute sessions, with ice skating instruction and one 30-minute session with off-ice strength training.

There is also a daily rehearsal for recital.

Camp will end with a Friday recital (approximately 11:15am for morning session and 4:30pm for afternoon session).

Skaters less than 6 years are required to wear helmets.



REFUNDS are permitted prior to the beginning of the camps and are subject to a \$20 administrative fee. **AGES** 3 years through adult may join!
STUDENTS RECEIVE group instruction, practice ice and the use of rental skates. **LEARN** proper off-ice stretching, off-ice warm-up techniques, and on-ice warm-up techniques. If registration is not adequate, class may be canceled and refunds will be given.
